


Pharmacists and Medication Management: A Personalized Service for You


With medications and diseases becoming more and more complicated, it is essential that you ensure the health care you and your family receives is the absolute best available. Medication Management is the latest project initiated by the BC Ministry of Health Services that will help you achieve that. Imagine having a doctor, nurse, pharmacist and others on the same team working together to solve your health needs—that is what Medication Management can do for you.



How does Medication Management Work?

Medication Management is the idea that all of the health professionals involved in your care work as a team and focus on their individual strengths. Specifically, the pharmacist will assess your medications and provide recommendations in a personalized care-plan for you and your doctor to review. This will allow your doctor to spend more time with you during your appointment to focus on the diagnosis and physical assessment, rather than on the medications.

Medication Management is different from typical advice you get from your pharmacist because the pharmacist now takes a greater role in choosing drug therapy. In order for your pharmacist to complete a personalized care-plan, a 10-15 minute consultation is often necessary to obtain information. The time spent with your pharmacist during a consultation is above and beyond the time you would save in an appointment with your doctor, which means you can address your health issues faster and avoid repeated visits.





Why does my doctor need a care-plan from the pharmacist?

As a member of your health care team, pharmacists are the medication experts and can provide a wealth of information. A pharmacist is the best resource for any questions related to medications and can also provide disease management advice, signs and symptoms to watch for, medication adverse reactions and medication contraindications. Armed with your personalized care-plan, your doctor can confidently make therapy decisions knowing that they have been reviewed by a second opinion.

How does Medication Management help me?

The benefits of Medication Management are simple: have more skilled health professionals looking out for your best interests and you will get better health care. Traditionally, if you wanted this kind of service you would have to approach the pharmacist, have a similar consultation, but then be responsible for relaying any of that information to your doctor. With Medication Management, the work you do does not change, but now you can have a pharmacist consultation with peace of mind knowing that everything discussed will be in the care-plan that you and your doctor can review.

The personalized care-plan is also your copy of all of your medications, doses and strengths, allergies and disease information that you can always refer back to or carry around in your wallet. In addition, Medication Management has shown to:

- > reduce problems caused by medications
- > reduce hospitalizations
- > reduce emergency visits
- > reduce waiting times
- > lower health care costs
- > improve understanding of your medications
- > improve management of health conditions such as asthma, diabetes, high blood pressure, heart disease and depression

Implementation of Medication Management

The project is now underway at participating pharmacies, including Howe Sound Pharmacy. Individuals are encouraged to participate and invest in improving your own health care. Most consultations can be done with the pharmacist right away, but complex or stubborn problems that may take longer to discuss should be done in a scheduled appointment. Appointments can be made via phone or in person. Howe Sound Pharmacy also offers an added service of home visits by the pharmacist if you cannot make it to the pharmacy.
